

## Consent Packet Checklist

### Items you need to return to the Corps of Engineers to apply for a Consent Agreement:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Survey of area to be dredged.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Survey of disposal area where material is to be placed. (*Does not apply if using Eagle Island*)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Sediment sample analysis.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ Map showing where the sediment samples are taken from.
5. \_\_\_\_\_ Copy of the CAMA Permit or your application if permit has not been granted and your CAMA contact information.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ A check made out to “FAO, USAED, Wilmington” for the estimated amount of dredge material to be collected multiplied by \$5.00.
7. \_\_\_\_\_ Volume quantity calculations for material to be dredged and capacity of the disposal area.
8. \_\_\_\_\_ Permission letter to use the disposal area from the underlying property owner. (*Does not apply if using Eagle Island disposal area in Wilmington*)
9. \_\_\_\_\_ One digital and one paper copy of everything above.
10. \_\_\_\_\_ The Tax ID form for the entity (Marina) doing the dredging (W-9 Form). (<http://www.irs.gov/>)

### Once the work is complete, the following items will need to be submitted:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Survey of the area that was dredged.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Survey of the disposal area where the materials were placed (*Does not apply if using Eagle Island*)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Final dredge volume quantities based on the differences between the pre- and post-dredge hydrographic surveys.
